OPUF ANALISYS

BASED UPON RECORDING FROM SPECTRE FLIGHT WE NOW HAVE PROOF OF RUSSIAN TU-160 BLACKJACK STRATEGIC BOMBER.

THE PHOTO EVIDENCE HAS BEEN HANDED OVER TO OUR POLITICAL LEADERS INDER FOR THEM TO PRESENT THIS IN THE UN SECURITY COUNCIL THERE HOPEFULLY BRING THIS CONFLICT TO AND END WITHOUT FURTHER LOSS OF LIFE.

GOOD PREPARATION AND DUE DILLIGENCE BY ALLIED FORCED HAVE SO FAR BEEN ABLE TO KEEP ENEMY AT BAY WITH RELATIVELY FEW LOSSES. WE HAVE LOST AIRFRAMES BUT USE OF APPROPRIATE COMBAT AIR PATROL, SURPRESSION OF ENEMY AIR DEFENCE, SKILLED PILOTS AND AWACS CREW HAVE KEPT THE NUMBERS LOW.

OPUF ANALISYS

VIS WOULD LIKE TO HIGHLIGHT SOME KEY POINT WHEN REPORTING INTEL AND BATTLE DAMAGE ASSESMENT.

- WHEN REPORTING INTEL/BDA A LOCATION AS LAT/LONG IS PREFERRED AS THIS WILL GIVE VIS A CLEAR PICTURE OF WHERE UNIT HAVE BEEN SPOTTED. AS REMARKS DIRECTION OF MOVEMENT CAN BE ADDED.
- IN CASES WHERE LOCATION PER LAT/LONG IS NOT PRACTICAL BEARING AND RANGE CAN BE USED BUT IT IS VITAL TO PROVIDE REFERENCE FROM WHERE.
- WHEN BDA/INTEL IS REPORTED BY TWO PARTIES, E.G. FLIGHT ITSELF AND AWACS/JTAC AND THERE IS A DISCRENPANSY BETWEEN THE TWO VIS HIGHLY RECOMMEND SORTING THE DISCREPANCY AND UPDATE THE REPORTS.
- WHEN REPORTING IT IS ABSOLUTELY VITAL TO STATE WHETHER INTEL OR BDA. OTHERWISE VIS WILL DISCARD THE INFORMATION

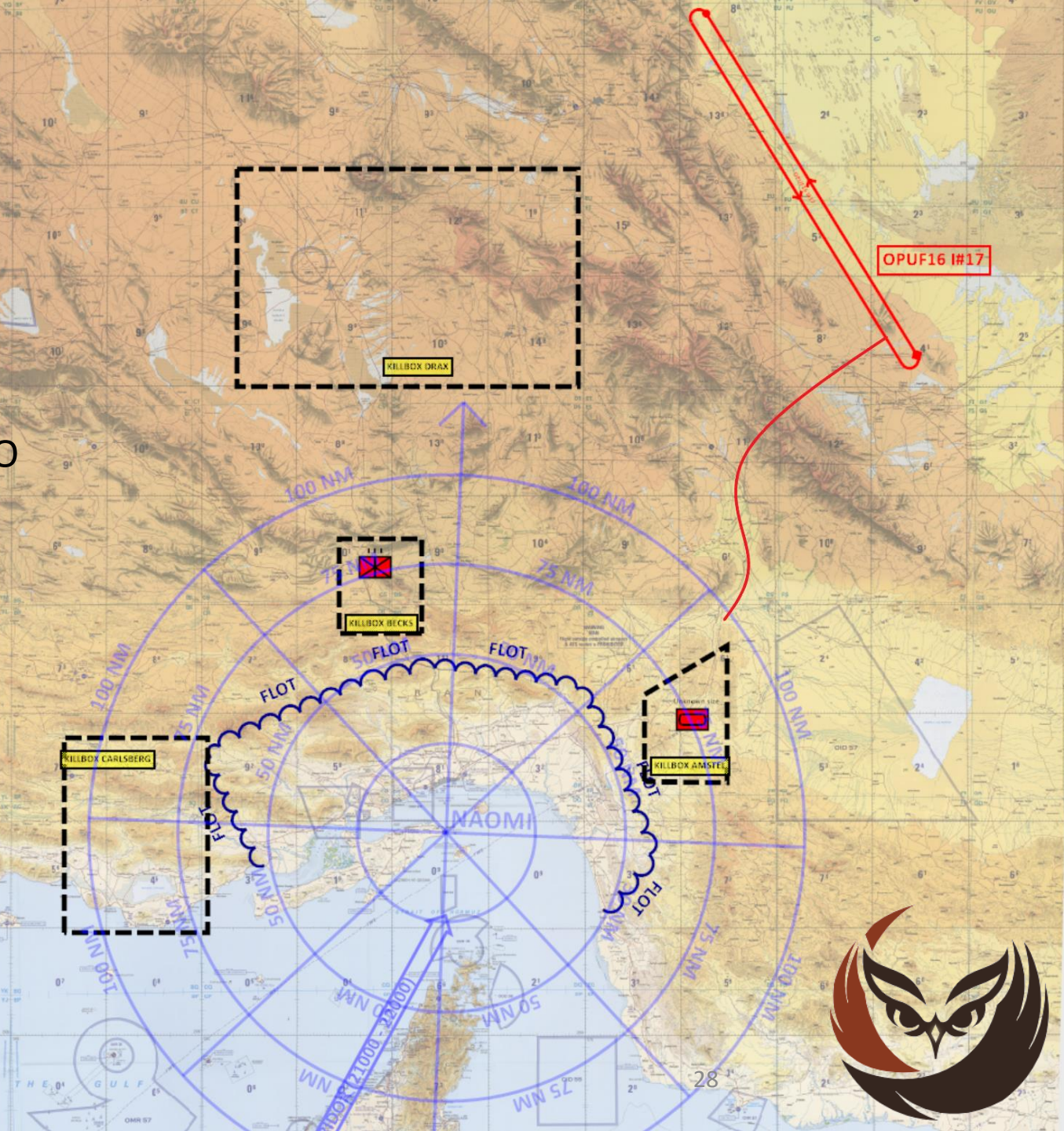


OPUF ANALYSIS

EASTERN FRONT

VIS HAVE STARTED TO SEE A HIGH INFLUX OF ENEMY FORCES INTO EASTERN FRONT. MOST LIKE THESE FORCES HAVE BEEN AIRLIFTED INTO THE AREA AS AWACS REPORTED INTEL SUGGESTED DURING OPUF MSN 16

CONCLUSION: ALLIED FIGHTERS SHOULD UTILIZE ANY OPPORTUNITY TO TAKE DOWN ENEMY TRANSPORT AIRCRAFT FLYING IN THE NORTH EASTERN AREA OF THE AO AS THEY WILL MOST LIKELY BE CARRYING REINFORCEMENTS.



OPUF ANALISYS

UN-IDENTIFIED ARMORED REGIMENT - BRAVO

BASED UPON THE BDA BY AR FLIGHT IN KILL BOX AMSTEL WE HAVE CONCLUDE THAT BDA of T-72's WERE IN FACT REMAINS OF ARMORED REGIMENT BRAVO AND NOT A NEW PLAYER ON THE BATTLE FIELD

BASED UPON THIS THE ARMORED REGIMENT BRAVO HAS COMPLETELY BEEN WHIPPED OUT

CONCLUSION: THEY HAVE BEEN COMPLETELY INIHALATED.



OPUF ANALISYS

UN-IDENTIFIED MECHANIZED INFANTRY REGIMENT - CHARLIE

BASED UPON THE BDA FROM MISTY WE HAVE NOT BEEN ABLE TO CONFIRM PRESENCE OF A SECOND MECHANIZED INFANTRY REGIMENT, HOWEVER THE PRESENCE OF SAO-2S9 SELF PROPELLED ARTILLIARY/MORTAR HAS BEEN ESTABLISHED

THE BULK OF THE MECHANIZED INFANTRY HAVE YET TO BE FOUND.

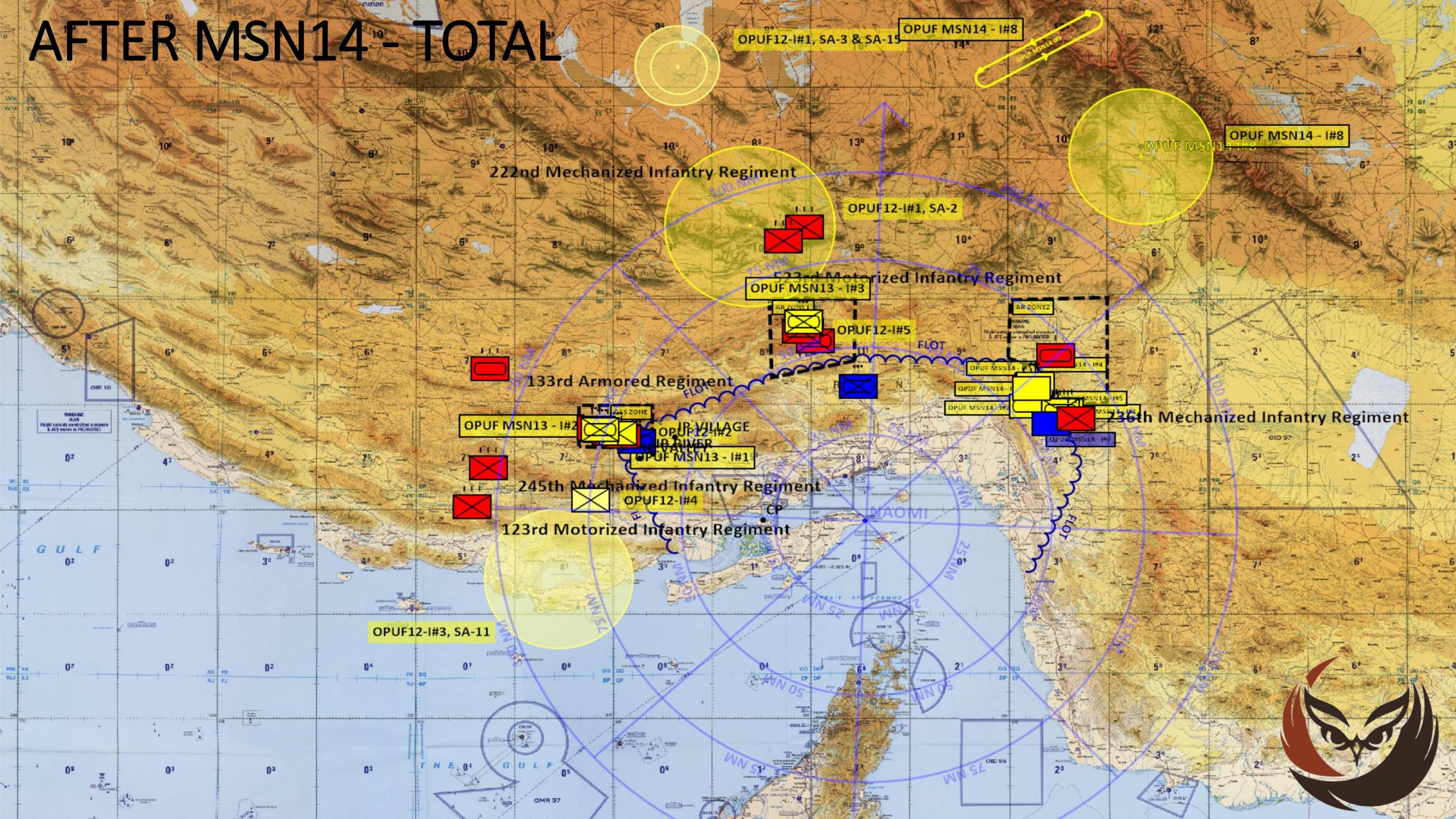


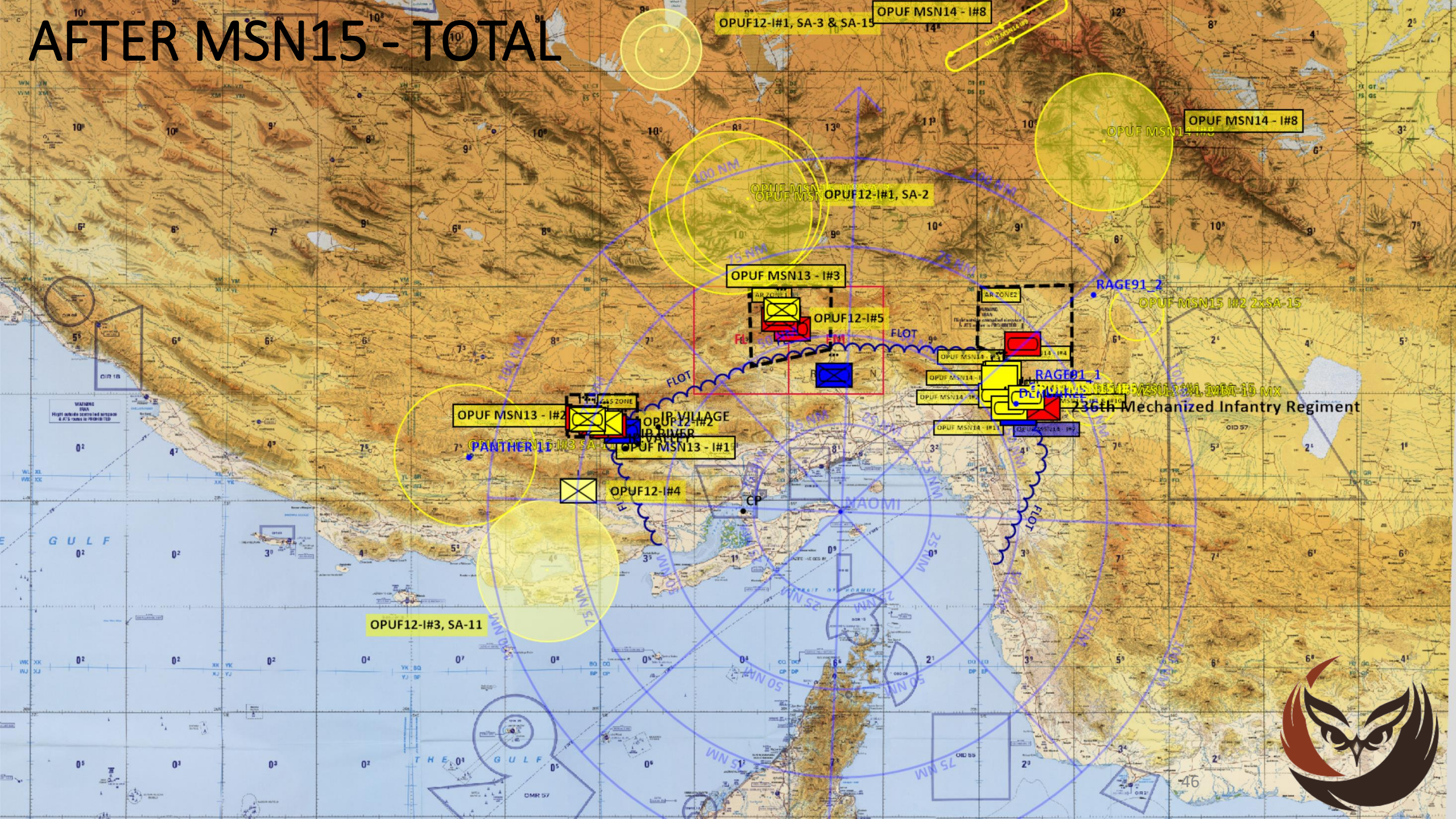

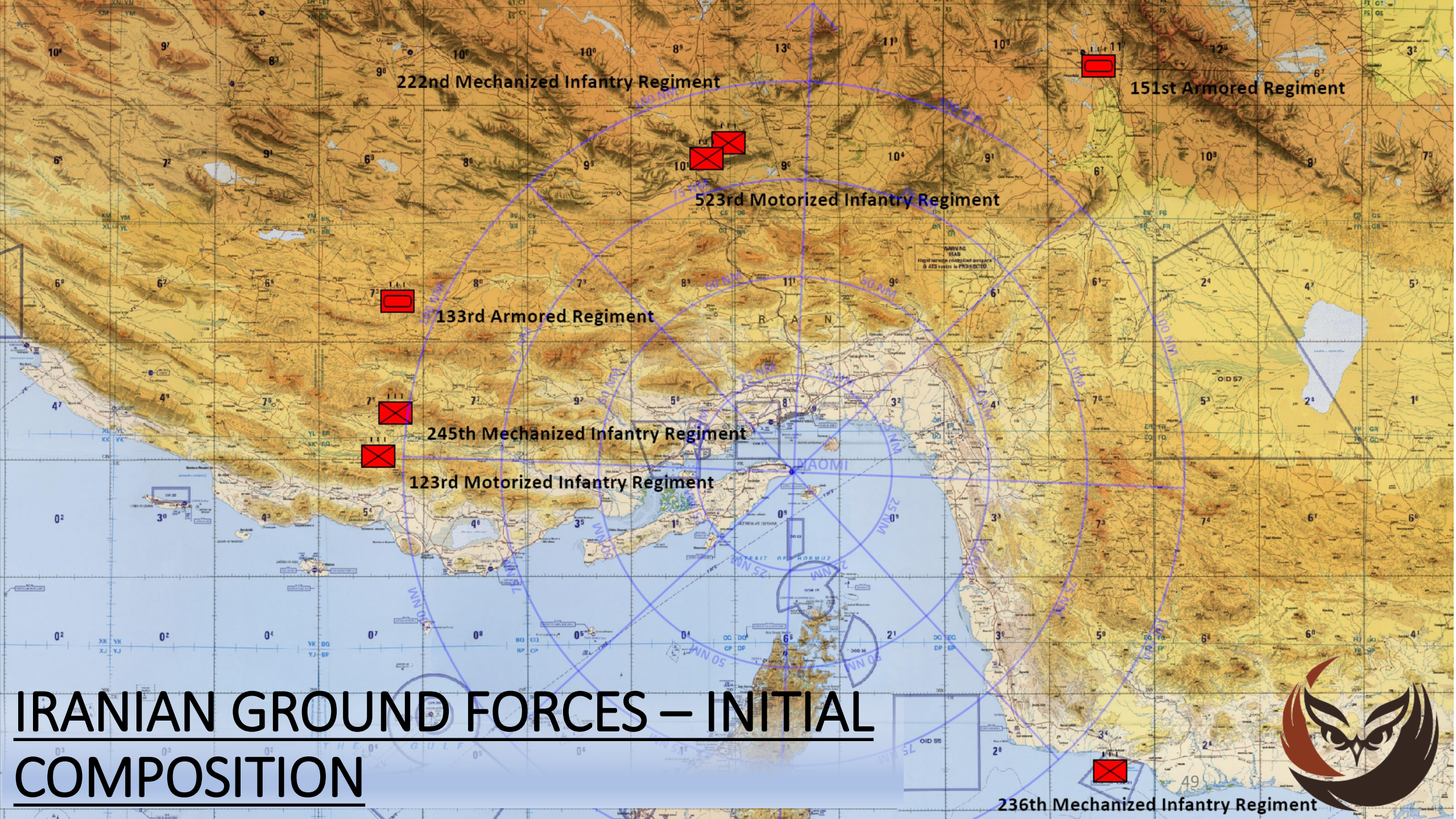
